There's nothing like the delightfully tart sweet flavor and firm crisp texture of Noma blueberries. Loaded with natural goodness, including an abundance of antioxidants, fiber and vitamin C, these intensely blue gems are in high demand as a healthy addition to everyday meals, snack foods, a wide variety of baked goods as well as sauces, jams and syrups.

Cultivars of distinction

Recognizing the steadily increasing demand for premium quality, all-purpose blueberries, Noma maintains its blueberry orchards with Duke, Legacy, Bluecrop, Bluegold, and O'Neil cultivars, renowned for their superior flavor, sweetness and size.

An abundance of blueberries

Noma's blueberry orchards are well positioned in Kobuleti, a town in Ajara in south-western Georgia, with rich soils and a subtropical climate ideal for the propagation of blueberries. With



harvests that begin mid-June through to the end of July, state-of-the-art cold storage facilities on premise, and Global G.A.P. certification that ensures proper handling and storage, blueberries are abundant and readily available.

All of Noma's blueberries are packed for retail sales in 500gm container and, for applications requiring larger quantities, in 3kg bulk containers. Custom packaging is available for customers seeking private label presentations.

Dried fruits & medicinal herbs

In addition to its blueberry orchards, Noma maintains a drying facility for bilberry (wild forest blueberries), rosehips, sea buckthorn, helichrysum arenarium (immortelle) and eucalyptus. All of these dried products are processed and packed for export in 15kg to 25kg bags for applications requiring large volumes of raw material.
